MultiTrans 2019 SP1 Release Notes

New features and enhancements

Here are the new features and enhancements available in MultiTrans 2019 SP1.

New look and feel throughout the TMS

The Customer Portal has been redesigned with a clean new look and new information available within the **Dashboard**.

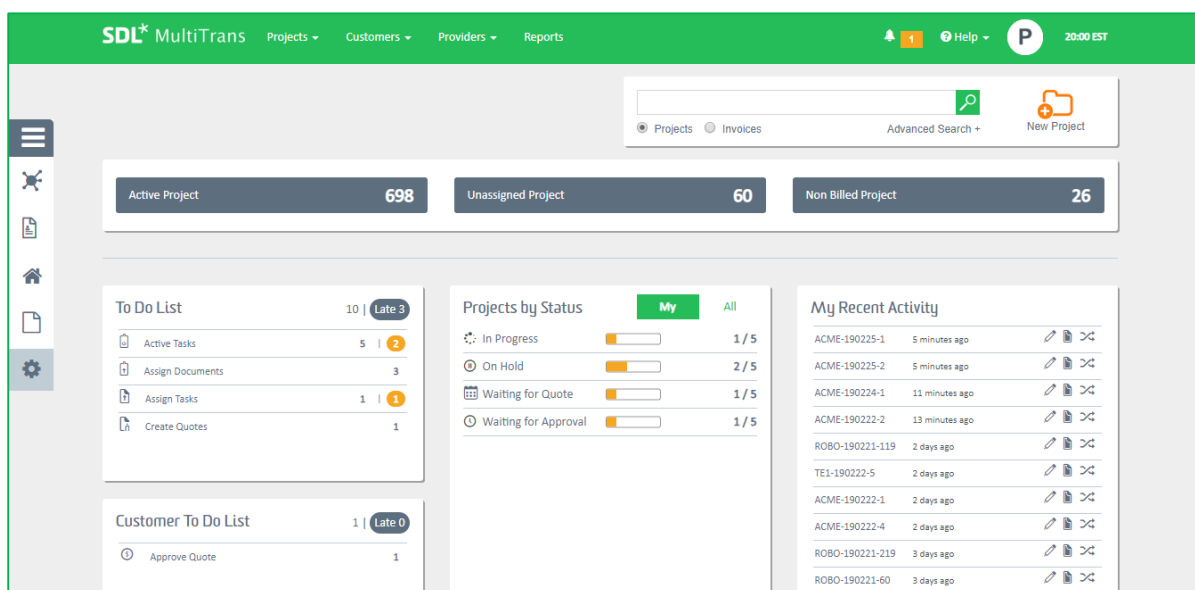

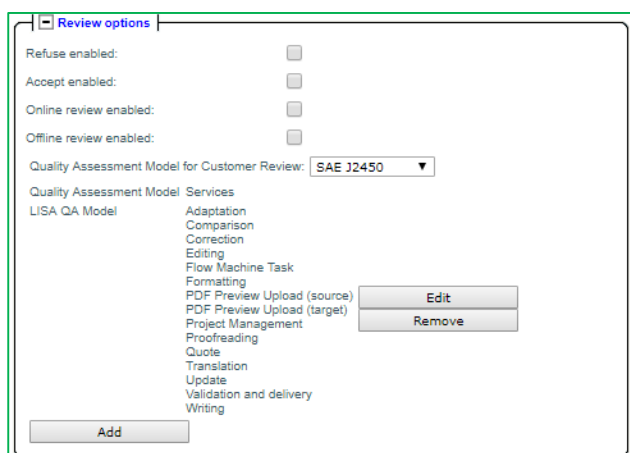


Additional style changes have been made throughout the TMS, including on the self-training pages.

Customer Portal Usability Features

Minimum delivery timelines can be enforced automatically. Set the minimum delivery timeframe in the Project Manager Portal (**Settings > System Parameters > PCF**), and customers will not be able to submit projects due within a shorter timeframe than specified.

Customers can provide post-delivery reviews, either requesting corrections or accepting the delivery. Enable the reviews within **Settings > System Parameters > General**, and select whether the review is to be done online through the Web Editor or offline, and whether a quality assessment form can be filled out as part of the review.

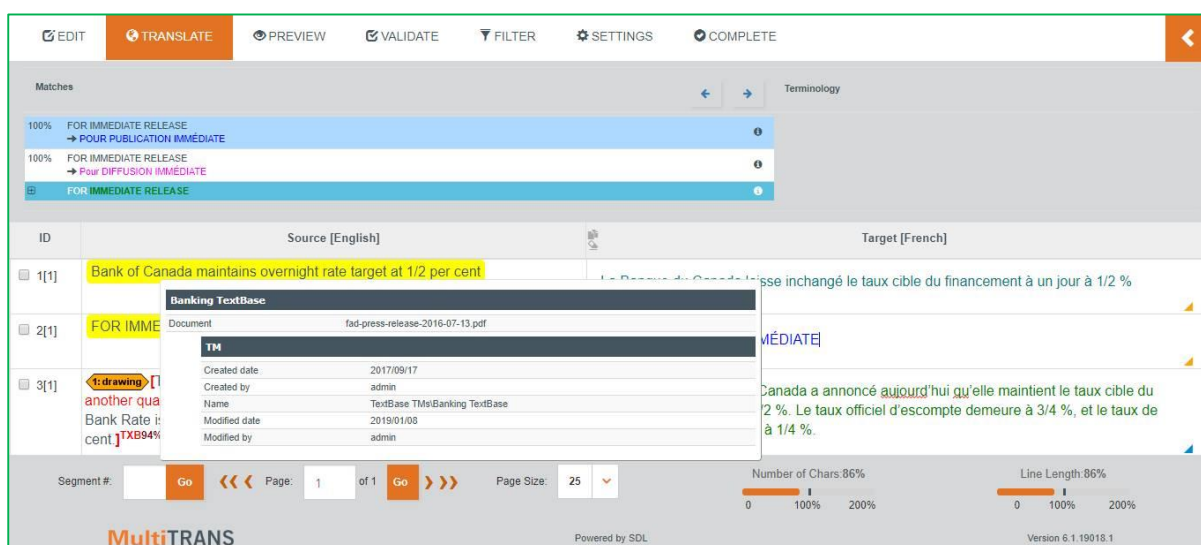


Dynamic workflow templates can be included in the **Services List** on the **Project Creation Form** by selecting **Show in the PCF** within **Settings > Flow Administration & Automation > Dynamic Workflow Templates**.

The **Also Deliver To** field is multi-value within the default **Project Creation Form (PCF)**. Existing customised PCFs remain unchanged.

BeGlobal Integration

A connector to SDL’s neural machine translation engine BeGlobal has been added. Configure this in the Administration Console (**Search Add-ons**), and retrieve high-quality machine translations as suggestions within the XLIFF Editor, Web Editor, Pre-translation and Office Add-ins.



Project Management Usability Features

View the amount of work to be done for a particular project directly from the **Dashboard** or **Project Lists**. Click the drop-down arrow beside a project in the table and select **Units**.

Technical Enhancements

The REST API **getProjectDetails** method returns all units for a particular task.
Enhanced logging has been added for quicker troubleshooting should an issue arise.

Program updates

1. Project managers can search by project number using the **Advanced Search**.
2. Project managers can filter on language pairs in the dashboard and project list tables. The filtered value is correctly displayed in the tag above the table contents.
3. Target languages are displayed correct in the **Overview** tab for projects with more than ten target languages.
4. Customers cannot create more than one project by rapidly clicking **Submit** from the Project Creation Form.
5. The delivery mode option *Cannot attach documents* is considered when submitting projects from the Project Creation Form.
6. Capitalization is ignored when comparing project source and delivered target file names.
7. Dynamic workflow templates can be automatically applied to projects created via connectors or the APIs.
8. Project groups can be created using the SOAP API without including a projectgroupcode.
9. The REST API will filter getProjects based on the projectStatus.
10. MultiTrans does not assign long file names to files in storage.
11. Errors are logged correctly if emails cannot be sent due to misconfiguration of the mail options.
12. Math nodes in Word documents are imported as inline elements.
