# MultiTrans 7 Patch 7.0.20084.2 – 7.0.20143.1

## New Features

1. (53397) Providers with the appropriate access given can share their task lists with other users, who can then quote, accept, perform and complete these tasks. Audit trails track the user who performed the task, all other reporting and views display the assigned user.
2. (53768) The level of effort for each task in a workflow can be calculated automatically based on the Flow Machine Task – MultiTrans Analysis and the configured capacity for that service and assigned provider. This is represented as **Bill(h)** and **Pay(h)** in the project workflows, where **Bill(h)** is the customer level of effort based on the system **Default Productivity** and **Pay(h)** is the provider level of effort based on the individual provider's productivity.
3. (53941) An option to display field values in alphabetical order has been added for custom list, combo box and multi-combo box fields. If this option is not selected, field values continue to display in the manually-selected order.
4. (52920) The search by partial document name in the Project Manager Portal has been optimized for greater speed and lower CPU usage.

## Program Updates

5. (7133) A sporadic exception causing TextBase updates from Flow to fail has been resolved.
6. (54003) TextBases can be updated immediately from Flow.
7. (54205) Document-level metadata can be added to TextBases from the Auto-Align Scheduler using HTTPS.
8. (53980) Users can clear the value of a date field when adding document-level metadata to TextBases through the Auto-Align Scheduler.
9. (52256) Document-level metadata values can be saved through the MultiTrans desktop client.
10. (54447) All items in the **Configuration** menu of the MultiTrans desktop client can be opened correctly.
11. (54129) The reverse translation penalty in the XLIFF Editor is calculated correctly.
12. (54131) The indirect translation penalty in the XLIFF Editor is calculated correctly.
13. (54582) Files can be printed from the XLIFF Editor.
14. (54090) There are no errors displayed when scrolling through a document in the XLIFF Editor in which some segments have been translated and others duplicated.
15. (54185) When exporting files from XLIFF where tags were missed during translation, overlapping tag pairs are corrected automatically.
16. (50490) Ctrl+End moves the cursor to the last segment when the last page of the document is selected in the Web Editor.
17. (52910) The back arrow on the **Preview**, **Validation**, **Filter** and **Settings** windows of the Web Editor has been removed.
18. (52612) Users are not prompted to replace identical segments when using the **Go to segment** functionality.
19. (46342) The last two segments in a document can be merged in the Web Editor.
20. (54805) Users to whom Web Editor tasks are re-assigned can log into those tasks correctly.

21. (53265) Access to Web Editor tasks using customer-customized URLs is granted appropriately.
22. (53764) Improvements have been made to the pre-translation of hidden text in Word documents.
23. (53210) Tables of contents are formatted correctly in target documents on export from XLIFF.
24. (53222) SmartArt is exported correctly from XLIFF.
25. (52855) Cancelled projects are not included in the alerts shown in the Project Manager Portal dashboard.
26. (6970) The display order of list, combo box and multi-combo box field values is correct in custom PCFs.
27. (54026) Asterisks (\*) denoting mandatory fields on custom PCFs line up with the field label.
28. (48149, 54137) Target language codes are displayed correctly in the [Project Overview](#) of projects with a large number of target languages.
29. (54268) The page in which a dynamic workflow template can be selected from the [Project Overview](#) resizes correctly.
30. (54027) Providers created through Flow with a mandatory password change on next login can successfully reset their passwords.
31. (54267) In-progress workflows can be deleted.
32. (54995) Mail configuration values are initialized properly.
33. (52303) The [Translate](#) test button can be used prior to saving a new SDL Cloud or SDL Edge machine translation configuration in the Administration Console.
34. (53759) The initialization of the MultiTrans database and audit database during installation of the MultiTrans Server has been streamlined.
35. (53758) Unnecessary errors messages have been removed when initializing the MultiTrans databases.
36. (48014) MultiTrans version 6.0 databases can be updated successfully.
37. (54103) The proper help files are linked to the Project Manager Portal.
