
# How to re-install the MultiTrans Client

Before proceeding, please close all programs including the MultiTrans Client itself and refer to the following documentation to back up any local resources on your computer:



## Step 1 – Uninstall MultiTrans

Click the Start Menu and open the Control Panel:




#### Click Uninstall a program:



Scroll down the list and click on MultiTrans, then click Uninstall:

### Uninstall or change a program


To uninstall a program, select t from the list and then click Uninstall, Change or Repair.




Click **Yes** to confirm that you want to uninstall MultiTrans:



If this message appears on your screen, click Yes:




When you are prompted to restart your computer, you may select No:



In the list of installed programs, look for **Microsoft Visual C++ Redistributable**. There are likely to be multiple occurrences of this with a different version number next to each one. **Uninstall each one that is version 14.0.23506 and above**:

To uninstall a program, select it from the list and then click Uninstall, Change or Repair.




# Step 2 – Uninstall Microsoft SQL Server

Please note that this step is not required if Microsoft SQL Server is not installed on your computer.


Look at the list of installed programs and look for **Microsoft SQL Sever 2008 R2**. If it is not installed, skip to Step 3, otherwise select it then click **Uninstall**:


#### Click **Select All** then click **Next**:





Click **Remove**. This part may take a few minutes to complete:




Once this has completed, click Close:



From the list of installed programs, select each item with **Microsoft SQL Server 2008** in its name and **uninstall** them:


#### Uninstall or change a program

To uninstall a program, select it from the list and then click Uninstall, Change or Repair.




Once you've uninstalled the above programs, go to the following folder:

#### C:\Program Files\Microsoft SQL Server



Click on the folder named **MSSQL10\_50.MULTITRANS** then delete it. If you're prompted to provide administrator permissions, click **Continue**:




Now restart your computer.

# Step 3 – Install MultiTrans


Before proceeding, please make sure that you have restarted your computer and closed all other programs.

Right-click on the MultiTrans installer and select **Run as administrator**:




If this message appears on your screen, click **More info** then click **Run Anyway**:








Click the checkbox to accept the License Agreement, then click **Next**:





#### Click **Install**. This may take a few minutes to complete:







# Step 4 (ExternalTranslator only) – Modify the Windows Registry


Now click the Start Menu and search for **regedit**, then click to open the **Registry Editor** program:



Alternatively, you can find this under **Start > Windows Administrative Tools > Registry Editor**:




If you see this message appear on your screen, click Yes:




Copy and paste the following into the text box at the top of the window, then press Enter:



Right-click on LaunchServerProcess then click Modify...:



Select the **Decimal** option, then type the number **2** in the Value data field and click **OK**:



Now restart your computer.
