MultiTrans 7 Patch 7.0.19350.1 – 7.0.20041.2.0

New Features

1. (51509) Customer contacts with appropriate access rights can create and submit projects on behalf of other users within their organization. The submitting user will automatically be added to the [Also Deliver To](#) field, and the information of user on whose behalf the project is submitted is automatically filled in. The audit trails will continue to track the users performing each action.
2. (51467) Existing projects can be cloned by customer contacts for ease of submission. Cloning a project opens the user's Project Creation Form (PCF), whether it be default or customized, automatically filling in the submitting user's information. With the exception of the target date, the source files and any [Direct Text Translation](#), all information from the existing project is preserved and editable.
3. (51508) Statuses with no projects are not displayed in the Customer Portal [Projects by Status](#) list.
4. (51769) Users created in MultiTrans Flow can be mandated to change their passwords on next login, whether they are imported through CSV or XML files or created manually. This option is not available to single sign-on (SSO) users.
5. (51088, 51089) MultiTrans custom languages can be mapped to [SDL Machine Translation Edge](#) and [SDL Machine Translation Cloud](#) languages.
6. (51778) Units can be weighted, to give a generic level of effort for tasks. For example exact match results can represent less effort than fuzzy match results, which can in turn represent less effort than new words. The weighted unit totals are displayed throughout MultiTrans Flow and are available in notification templates, CSV exports and several reports.
7. (50719, 51750, 51751) Two-factor authentication tokens are only sent to devices specifically registered to contacts and providers. Contacts and providers can view and manage the devices from their profiles, and administrators and project managers can manage devices on behalf of contacts and providers.

Program Updates

1. (51414) Expired passwords can be changed through the MultiTrans Web.
2. (47739) Non-breaking spaces () are preserved when exporting from XLIFF files to the target file format.
3. (50395) Customer Review tasks start correctly when multiple files are uploaded to the previous task.
4. (50615) The [Missing Tags](#) filter correctly identifies erroneous translation units following a preview.
5. (52020) Double-byte characters can be added in the Web Editor following a tag at the end of a segment.
6. (50780) The name of the provider who edited a segment is hidden from the Tracked Changes view in the Web Editor.
7. (51353) Tracked changes colors are not affected by the addition of tags to a segment in the Web Editor.

8. (51352) Removed tags display in the correct location of the Tracked Changes view of the Web Editor.
9. (51865) Tracked changes are displayed correctly in the Web Editor when the first word of a segment is modified.
10. (52249) Tags are duplicated correctly when duplicating segments in the Web Editor.
11. (51281) Notes can be added to segments accessed through the [Go To](#) option.
12. (52321) Reports can be generated from the Provider Portal.
13. (52585) The service name displays correctly when a static workflow template is applied to multiple languages.
14. (52531) Projects with multiple target languages and automatic application of dynamic workflow templates are created without error messages.

Note

The feature (51509) allows creating projects on behalf of other contacts. This feature applies to the default Project Creation Form (PCF). Configurations using custom PCFs will not be affected, although the access right will be visible in the solution. To inquire if this feature can be added to your custom PCF, contact your account representative.
