Overview


Bynder is a Digital Asset Management system and RWS offers a connector:

- It is a paid connector licensable through RWS
- First line support is through RWS
- The connector was developed by our friends at Trivalent (thank you!)
- The intellectual property is owned by RWS


Functional Overview

- It is installed via the Add-On Manager
- Under the hood it uses the Integration Framework introduced in Sites 9.1
- Content Authors can Search, Browse and Select media from Bynder
- Media metadata is available through GraphQL queries to the DXD Content Hub

Get Bynder OAuth Settings



Go into Portal Settings



Go OAuth Apps and Add new app

Bynder will generate a ClientId and ClientSecret for you to use in the next step.

Edit the Bynder JSON file

Put in the OAuth information (ClientId and ClientSecret) in multiple places.
Add the baseURL to your Bynder portal (ie: <https://mycompany.getbynder.com>)

In the “siteCm” section, put in a the tcm id of a “Stubs” folder that will hold the references to your connectors. Usually a “Stubs” folder is high up in the BluePrinting hierarchy so that the downstream Publications can inherit the connector.
